

BEALINGS IN THE GRAIN PITS

THE MARKET ABOUT AT A STAND-STILL.

WITH FLUCTUATIONS WITHIN VERY NARROW LIMITS IN WHEAT, CORN AND OATS—THE PROVISION MARKETS QUIET. LIVESTOCK MARKETS.

March 21.—Wheat opened up at 100 1/2 above yesterday's closing price for May. The former feeling was caused by the fact that the Cincinnati Price Current stated that "low supplies of wheat are being uniformly reported." One cause for the present satisfaction lay in the smallness of the European continental markets, notwithstanding the weakness which has prevailed here since yesterday. The opening advance was succeeded by a weaker feeling, due to the domestic situation. The receipts at Minneapolis and Duluth today were 362 cars, against 273 cars on Thursday a week ago and 240 cars on the corresponding day last week. Advances from the northwest were in effect that receipts from farmers this week would amount to about 2,000,000, or less than last week's farmers' deliveries. Atlantic port clearances, including wheat, amounted to a total of only 150,000 bushels, including flour, oats and other cereals. The export movement in wheat was not so active as it had been in the last few days. Receipts were 121 cars, against 147 cars on Thursday, and 147 cars on Wednesday. The market was fairly active. Selling of May and July of July reduced the difference between the two contracts to 1 1/2. Cash wheat was 1 1/2 lower and that of the future somewhat. May closed at 100 1/2, and July at 101 1/2. Flour was very firm. Pork closed at 10 1/2, and lard at 7 1/2. Receipts Friday—Wheat, 400 cars; corn, 100 cars; oats, 120 cars; hogs, 100 head.

COTTON HAD A SLIGHT BACKSET

A LOSS OF SIX TO EIGHT POINTS ON THE DAY.

LIVERPOOL WAS WEAKER AND THAT DOMINATED THE OTHER MARKETS—THE RECEIPTS AND SHIPMENTS AT ALL PORTS. RANGE OF PRICES.

New York, March 21.—Cotton market opened irregularly at unchanged to 2 points lower, sold off six points by midday. The afternoon a partial rally took place, but the market closed weak at 62 1/2 points net decline. Total sales, 262,400 bales. Although the market showed general weakness and low activity, it did not yesterday. There was still enough business doing to make things very quiet and keep traders busy trying to guess what and how to trade. The decline was principally due to an unexpected weakness in the Liverpool market, which caused heavy local realization of cotton bought early in the week.
