Times have been so hard, so many thousands have been thrown out of employment and can not obtain even the necessities of life, that the question of charity has become one of the most vital of the hour in crowded communities.

To distribute assistance indiscriminately means, of course, that the professional and unscrupulous beggars will get the lion's share and rob many deserving people of even a bare pittance. The problem would be easy enough were all who ask worthy of help. No one desires to encourage the chronic and voluntary vagrant, and no one, or but few, would refuse aid to those who were honest.

As it is, in New York City a kind of "vagrant patrol" has been established, with the object of ridding the great army of helpless and unemployed of the professional pauper class and running the oil lamps out of the city. How well this plan may work it is not possible yet to determine, but it could certainly be made effective in smaller communities.

There is no telling how many poor the people of this city have fed and cared for this winter. Their names have been legion, and a family in Houston that has been saved upon one to half a dozen times a day for food or clothing. Many of the applicants have shown a willingness to work, others have shown an aversion to work and presented some plausible excuse for so doing.

In connection with the fact that Queen Victoria reigned for sixty-three years and her reign can be mentioned the names of other monarchs who have reigned for long periods. Regal.

Louis XIV of France reigned the unprecedented time of seventy-three years, and was succeeded by Louis XV, the great grandson, and this king reigned fifty-nine years. Thus two successive monarchs rule for the amazing time of 132 years.

The Spaniards boast justly of the reigns of some of their sovereigns. James I of Aragon ruled sixty-five years from 1213 to 1276, while Pedro IV and John II ruled respectively fifty-one and fifty-four years. From the time Spain was consolidated, in 1479, eight kings ruled whose reigns averaged thirty-five years. Alfonso I occupied Portugal's throne for seventy-three years (1112-1185), and he is regarded as the founder of their independence by the Portuguese.

Other Portuguese kings reigned for thirty-three, thirty-four and forty-six years. The reigns of several of the Braganza kings have been very long. Frederick Wilhelm, the great elector and ruler of the Prussian military power, reigned forty-eight years, from 1640 to 1688. Frederick the Great was on the throne forty-six years and this was about the most important reign in the annals of the kingdom. Frederick Wilhelm III reigned for forty-three years (1757-1806).
