

A DAY IN THE COURTS

DAMAGE SUITS SETTLED OUT OF COURT BY RAILROAD COMPANY.

Criminal District Court, February Term, Expired at Midnight, as Did Also January Term of Judge Wilson's Court.

The January term of the fifty-fifth judicial district court expired by limitation of law at midnight, March 1. This is the general construction, but as the civil district courts are in simultaneous session Judge Wilson has his doubts as to whether the term expires at midnight on the last day of the term or whether it expires with the opening of the next term.

The February term of the criminal district court expired by limitation last night at midnight. Judge Gillespie had his matters all filed and ready for the opening of the term, which was virtually closed, so far as Judge Gillespie's business was concerned, on Friday, when he held a short term in the afternoon.
