

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

Edots, lunaties, papers supported by the county all persons convicted of felony not restored to the right of suffrage by the governor, and all soldiers, mariners and seathen in the army or navy of the United States are not allowed to register. No previous registration reruthearts will be accepted at the steelon for which this registration is held. Under the law, all pursons applying to vote in the city of Houston must be registered first, and have the registrar's certificate insuch hefore they can vote, and every maje person of fereign birth, subject to none of the disqualibrations aforestid, who, at any time hefore an election, shall have declared his intention to become a citizen of the Daited States, in accordance with the Federal materialization laws, and shall have resided in this State one year next preceding such election, and the last air months in the county in which he offers to vote, abill also be deemed a qualified voter.
