REVIEW OF MARKETS

New York, April 1.—Many advances were recorded in the stock market today on very large dealings for the two hours, nearly two-thirds of a million shares changing hands.

The dealings were much influenced by the buoyancy of Manhattan, which made an extreme gain of 15 points, 9 of which it held.

Shorts in Manhattan covered large lines that had been put out in expectation that the new issue of stock would depress the price.

Discrimination was exercised against some of the highly manipulative specialties, and when they were taken as collateral the highest money rates prevailing were charged.

The bond market generally exhibited a good tone, with active lines, showing the most strength in the movement.
