ANGLO-AMERICAN CONVENTION

HOW FRANCE VIEWS THE NEW TREATY.

(Copyright, 1900, The Associated Press.)

Paris, Feb. 10.—The Anglo-American Convention, which permits American construction of the Nicaragua canal, has not yet attracted the keen attention here which its importance warrants, considering the heavy French financial interests thereby affected. The Panama canal has been a well in which nine French peasants out of every ten, attracted by specious promises, invested some part of their savings wrung from French soil.

Official of the Foreign Office has authorized the Associated Press to make the following statement:

"Far from making any objections to the Hay-Pauncefote convention, France hails with the greatest satisfaction its probable ratification. Its terms coincide precisely with those of the convention signed by the powers at Constantinople in 1883 regarding the neutrality of the Suez canal. It was France which proposed those terms. Though only theoretically in effect now, they represent France's wishes. If France satisfied with the regulation controlling a canal so closely identified with her interests she cannot but be pleased that the same terms apply to a canal in a section of the world where her interests are not involved.

"Efforts to connect the Panama interests with the convention will be futile, because they are not involved, as the treaty does not select a route, but only opens the way for an American canal across the isthmus and does not designate its position. In no way does it conflict with Panama. While individuals in France are deeply interested financially in Panama, it is a private corporation and not a government concern. France's consent to the Hay-Pauncefote convention will be readily and willingly forthcoming."

The suggestion that France shall demand an indemnity for injury to the Panama canal interests is scouted in unimpeachable circles.

FIGHTING JOE WHEELER.

WILL LEAVE FOR WASHINGTON IN A FEW DAYS.

Birmingham, Ala., Feb. 10.—General Joe Wheeler, writing to the chairman and members of the River and Harbor Committee from Panama, Island of Luzon, under date of January 6, asks their active efforts in securing an appropriation for the Tennessee river below Chattanooga. General Wheeler says the death of General Lawton has delayed his departure for home. His letter reads in part:

"I expected to have been in Washington by the 1st of December, but I regarded it imperative that I should remain while the campaign was going on in November. In December it seemed that the insurrection was over and I prepared to leave, but the death of General Lawton apparently gave fresh encouragement to the insurgents, and I felt it my duty to remain a short time longer.

"I think the situation will soon be such as to justify my leaving, and I hope to start for Washington in a few days."
