

VIRGINIA NEWS AND NOTES.

Items of Interest From all Over the Old Dominion State.

A charming home wedding took place Wednesday afternoon at the residence of Judge Leigh E. Watts, at No. 202 Middle street, Norfolk, when the judge's oldest daughter, Miss Mary Reed, was led to the altar by Mr. Goodrich Hatton, a popular member of the bar of Portsmouth and Norfolk. Rev. J. D. Powell, rector of St. John's Church, solemnized the nuptials.

Norfolk Landmark: On Monday Dr. Butt was sent for to attend one of the Basses, living on the Galberry road, between Bower's Hill and Deep Creek, who had been bitten by a mule. Bass went into the stable where the animal was lying down and a deep crease in the mule made a savage bite on the man's ankle. Dr. Butt dressed the wound and made him as comfortable as possible. The mule died shortly afterwards. The mule was a very old one.

A meeting of railroad officials representing Virginia roads has been held at the office of Major E. T. Myers, in Richmond, for the purpose of adjusting the schedules of the several lines so as to make close connections as far as possible at the various junction points throughout the State. There were present at the meeting representatives of the Chesapeake and Ohio, Richmond and Danville, Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac, Norfolk and Western, Norfolk Southern, New York, Philadelphia and Norfolk, and other roads. After some conference on the subject it was found that the schedules now in effect were in most cases entirely satisfactory, with the exception of the connections made at Lynchburg. It was decided to hold another meeting on the 19th instant and adjust this matter as far as practicable, together with some others of a similar nature.
