### THOMAS FALLON Committed Suicide by Hanging.

Thomas Fallon, an Irishman, who was sent to the Eastern State Hospital recently from Newport News, committed suicide Thursday morning by hanging. Fallon was known to be of suicidal tendency and had been closely watched day and night. But like all suffering with this mania his opportunity came Thursday morning.

Concealing himself in his room till the attendants had taken all the other patients to breakfast he hastily tied a sheet around his neck, attached the other end to the bars at the top of the window and deliberately strangled himself to death. When found his feet were touching the floor.

Dr. Geo. A. Hankins, the city coroner, summoned a jury and held an inquest. The verdict of the jury completely exonerated the hospital authorities from any blame for the man's death.
