NEW YORK, June 10.—The stock market yesterday was forced to contend with renewal of the profit-taking and short selling which were effective in depressing prices during various periods last week.

Pressure ceased, however, when it became apparent that little real stock was coming out, and in the later dealings the market gave good response to such special developments as the government's excellent crop report and the removal of restrictions on gold movement and exchange operations, together with indications that the copper market was adjusting itself rapidly to meet the largely increased demands for that metal.

PITTSBURGH, June 10.—On the Pittsburgh Stock Exchange the boom in Arkansas Gas continued, the stock advancing to 66 1/2, a new high record, and closing at 66, a gain of 5 1/4 over Saturday.

There was much irregularity in the remainder of the list. American Window Glass Machine common declined \$1 to \$4, while the preferred was \$1 higher at 86.
