UNLESS something develops in the two succeeding bills at the Hipp. Zarrow's offering this week has no special attractions that make the entertainment unusually good. Eddie Loop has a peculiar style of comedy that seemed to please very much last night, and the accordion set went over well, leaving everybody hungry for more. The straight man would go well if there was much opportunity, but the present bill doesn't give him much show. The Darling sisters offer a specialty that is well costumed, and the dancing part of it goes over strong. The song, however, loses out, because of the tendency to contract the voice and squeeze it. The dancing bit, makes up for this shortage, however, very nicely, and the team which by the way is attractive looking got a rousing good encore. The chorus is there all right, although you can hardly see it. There has never been such a diminutive group of girls in line on the Hipp stage as we remember, but they are all good looking, are well costumed, and dance like experienced chorus girls. While there are no big flashes in the bill, it can be said to be of uniform quality throughout.

A Civil War Story. One of the strongest Civil War plays ever produced in this country was "The Warrens of Virginia" which ran for more than a year at Belasco's theatre in New York. The success of the play was phenomenal and it toured the country for several seasons with great success. It subsequently was picture-ized by Paramount and this has been re-issued by the same company.

The story is pretty well told in the screen, the plot being easily discerned all through. There are several exciting battle scenes in the picture, but aside from these, the story itself is highly thrilling. The picture was well produced and the support proved in every way satisfactory. 
