

**U.S. TO GET HONOR
ROLL TABLET TUESDAY**

**Ernest Showalter to Present It On Behalf of the
Barns Class.**

On next Tuesday evening at the Grand Opera house the bronze tablet, the gift of the Glenn F. Barns class, the Senior class this year of the Fairmont High school, to the school will be dedicated with appropriate ceremonies. The tablet contains the names of 191 members of the alumni of the school who saw service during the World War and was purchased by the class at a cost of \$600. The tablet stands five feet high and two and a half feet wide and is a very handsome piece of work.

Among the names engraved upon the tablet are those of Fred L. Heintzmann who lost his life in France while fighting for his country, and William Fleming, who died while his training was in training.
