BY THE CABLE.

LONDON, May 15.
In the House of Commons last night the bill moved by Mr. Gladstone to suspend the right of appeal in the Irish Church making appointments in the Irish Church passed its final reading. The bill is now in effect until the 1st of August, 1896. Late and important despatches have been received from Japan. The civil war was vigorously fought. THE FLORIDA ELECTION.

WASHINGTON, May 14.
Despatches to Gen. Grant from Jacksonville, May 14th, state that thirty-four counties give 5000 majority for the constitution, and Harrison Reed, the Republican candidate for Governor, 7000 majority. The Legislature is three-quarters Republican.

NEW YORK, May 18.

The Times Washington despatch says: There is a scheme to pass impeachment by vote of Senators to be admitted from Southern States. Another proposition is made to bring in all the re-constructed states by a concurrent resolution of Congress.

The Herald's despatch says: It is stated that the Arkansas Senators and those of several Southern States will be admitted soon and be enrolled among the Judges in the court of impeachment. The expulsion of Senators who voted for acquittal on the ground of corruption will be demanded.

THE ARKANSAS BILL.
