MIDDLEBURY.

The town meeting at Middlebury Tuesday was one of the most largely attended, most tumultuous and without one of the most good natured ones on record. It lasted from 10 a. m. until about 6 p. m. with an intermission of an hour and a quarter for dinner, and was thus one of the largest, if not the

longest, annual March meetings ever held in town. Town Clerk Brooks called the meeting to order, and C. M. Wilds, esq., was elected moderator. J. M. Slade, esq., one of the auditors, then explained the nature of the report, and got the selectmen in the proper account slimmer down to \$237. By request of the meeting, Agent Sayre and the former agent, B. E. Wales, came in and answered numerous questions fired at them by various persons present, but did not solve the mystery. The whole thing culminated in the adoption of a motion, instructing the selectmen not to purchase any more liquor for the agency this year, and another directing the selectmen to take the liquor away from the agency, lock them up and sell them to some other town agent, if legally possible. A committee of three was also appointed to investigate the matter of the deficit from the liquor business and see where, if it can be found, the deficit comes in, what has become of it and the profit that ought to have been made from the sales, the whole thing estimated at \$8000. The committee appointed were James A. Slade, George Rich and Professor E. E. Boyce. The poor matters were brought up also by Mr. Slade in his explanation of the auditors' report, and the matter was variously discussed. The matter was brought to a head in the afternoon with a set of resolutions proposed by A. P. Russell, esq., and adopted, which was that an effort be made to make a contract with some one to board the people on the town farm for a reasonable compensation.
