 Ordered that the assessment of Ann Hart, house and lot on Peace street in Canton be reduced from 200 to 100.
 Ordered that contract for building ferry boat at McKay's ferry on Pearl River be awarded to L B McKay for the sum of \$200, upon his giving bond and allowed sixty

days to complete said work.
 Ordered that A S Alve Co., be allowed for disinfectant fluid 16.35.
 Ordered that J C Kraft, manager of poor house at and for the sum of \$27.50 per month payable monthly for the year 1903.
 Ordered that Dr. W A Cheek be appointed physician to poor house for 1903 at the sum of \$10.00 per month paid monthly, he to visit poor house twice a month, and oftener if necessary.
 Ordered that the following named persons be allowed amounts opposite their names for holding inquest over the body of an unknown man at Ridgeland: W G Dorroh, J P., 5.00, P. L Porter, constable, 2.75, R H Thompson, juror, 1.00, L J Gossin, 1.00, Z Long, 1.00, H Love, 1.00, Dr A Brown, 1.00, J P Cook, 1.00,
 Ordered R W Stewart services rendered during the year 1902 as a member of Board of Supervisors see acts 1890 page 384. The amount being one hundred and fifty dollars it is ordered by the board now in session that a warrant be issued by the clerk of the board for 150.00 to R W Stewart to cover amount due him. The same under this act to J B Dendy, H H McGowan and F D Coleman.
 Upon application of the trustees of township 11, range 3 east for interest accrued, it is ordered that warrants be issued to James Cook for 65.00, and to J T Sharp for 85.00.
 Election for manager county farm and W T Smith was elected at a salary of 60.00 per month. H H McGowan ordered his vote recorded against.
 Dr S T Dunning elected jail and county farm physician at former salary and requirements.
 The treasurer presented his 2nd quarterly report, ending January 1st 1903, for examination, and the board examined and checked said report and found it correct in all things, and ordered said report filed and recorded as required by the statute.
