A VICTIM OF COCAINE

Give His Experience with the Fascinating Drug—Nursed Back to Health.

a great specific for nervous diseases, for certain diseases of the spine, for paralysis, for tetanus, hydrophobia and other convulsive diseases. It will unite with other anti-spasmodics and intensify their action.

"What are the effects of the drug?" "To begin with, it is like the effects of any stimulant at certain stages, but it is not stupefying, as is opium. The person taking it has a feeling that everything is lovely and serene, of perfect contentment and universal satisfaction."
