

THE NEW MADISON SQUARE GARDEN.

An Amphitheatre in New York Which Will Hold 14,000 People. Heretofore the largest amusement building in the United States has been the Auditorium at Chicago.

crowded full 14,000 people. It is estimated that 12,000 people saw the opening performance.

The building, which is not yet completed, occupies the entire block between Madison avenue and Fourth avenue, and Twenty-sixth street and Twenty-seventh street.

At present the eastern end of the amphitheatre is occupied by a stage, whose elaborate proscenium and curtain and splendid scenery form the most striking feature of the place.

Another remarkable fact is that notwithstanding the great width of the hall there are no pillars to obstruct the view. The great roof, supported by steel trusses of 186 feet span, which are said to be the largest and lightest in existence.

The great floor space in the center is surrounded by sloping tiers of seats, the top tier being about ten feet above the level of the street.

At the eastern end of the amphitheatre is the "state box," which will be reserved for the use of the president, the governor of the state or other high officials when they are present.

The prevailing tone of the decorations is similar to that of the Metropolitan Opera house—solid masses of cream white and light copper.

The lighting arrangements are simply dazzling. Along each of the roof girders incandescent lights have been placed at intervals of about a foot.

Besides this great amphitheatre the building contains—or will when it is finished—a tasteful theatre of good size and a splendid music hall.

There are only two things about the place which have so far been criticised. One is the lack of more exits. On the opening night the crowd had great difficulty in getting away after the show was over.
