Plenty of Men With Money Willing and Anxious to Take the New Bonds

The Embargo on American Cattle May Be Extended—Other News of the National Capital.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 20.—The indications are that the present government loan of \$50,000,000 will not only prove a complete success, but that the aggregate of bids will be far in excess of bonds to be sold.

The cash balance in the treasury today was \$100,234,177, gold reserve, \$60,711,517.

Kolb Men are Firm

WASHINGTON, Nov. 20.—Col. Lee Crandall, who ran for congress on the Kolb democracy ticket against Gen. Wheeler, in the Eighth Alabama district, is at the populist headquarters here, fresh from the conference of Kolb men, at which it was determined to issue the manifesto published today.

"The Oates men have the militia to back them, and the support of the administration, while we have not many arms, but you know what Napoleon said about right. Comparatively few Kolb men from the back districts were at the convention last week, because they were unable to get there, and we cannot tell how many will respond to the call on the first of December."

"There will be a contest made in the house against six of the democratic candidates who are given certificates of election, and we will present such indisputable evidence of frauds that the committee cannot overlook them."


