BUILDING IN BOZEMAN.—The year '72 will witness a progress in the improvement of Bozeman never before examined in the history of Montana, not even in the palmy days of Helena. The extreme cold weather only put a stop to the rapid building that was going on the fall, and the first opening of spring will be the signal for renewal on a more extensive and substantial scale. In the interim, it will probably please our readers to know who are the leading spirits in this movement to erect living monuments to their enterprise and build a city which will assume the proportions and commercial importance of the metropolis of Montana. Col. L. M. Black, whose enterprise is confined only within the scope of sound reason and good judgment, will erect several substantial buildings. A. Lamme & Co. will erect a magnificent brick store on the site of their old place, extending to the billiard hall. Ellis, Davis & Sperling intend putting up a substantial brick or stone building to accommodate their rapidly increasing business; and we understand that Mr. Nelson Story designs erecting a brick building for business houses, opposite his private residence; Messrs. Renshaw & Anderson intend, as soon as lumber can be procured, to put a furniture ware-house and manufactory on Black Street. We hear of other smaller business houses to be erected. The number of private houses will exceed those of a business character, and will depend somewhat upon the influx of population, which we have reason to believe will be pretty heavy.

BOZEMAN, January 10th, 1872. To the Editor of the Avant Courier: Sir: In your issue of the 8th ult. appeared the article headed "Corruption," and in that following a second one, embodying my note to you.

You take pains to inform me that the "Courier" is thoroughly independent in all things and of all persons. I reply to that, simply that, while I have no particular reason to doubt it, your assertion is not the opinion of many here who should be better able to judge in the premises than I can yet be.
