## EAGLE'S NEST HAILSTONE CON. MINING COMPANY

An effort is on foot to re-finance the Eagles' Nest and Hailstone properties of the old L. M. Sullivan company at Fairview, and a consolidation of the two has been made. The following letter from San Francisco has been received:

"Office of Eagle's Nest-Hailstone Consolidated Mining Company, 324 Bush Street.

"San Francisco, August 15.

"The Fairview Eagle's Nest Mining company and the Fairview Hailstone Consolidated Mining company, under the old management of the Sullivan Trust company and doing work to keep the properties alive, became indebted to the State Bank & Trust company for a considerable amount of money. Not having any treasury stock and not having any power to assess the shareholders, the present directors have been unable to prevent the receiver of the State Bank and Trust company from getting judgments against these companies and having the property sold under execution. It is this situation that made it necessary to take immediate steps to save, if possible, the property for all the stockholders.

"Messrs. Zadig & Company, brokers, San Francisco, who have been very successful in the reorganization of the Rescue Eula, have undertaken to do the same with the Fairview Eagle's Nest and Fairview Hailstone Mining companies, and, with that end in view, have taken the following steps:

## FILE PETITIONS FOR RECALL OF SEATTLE MAYOR

CHIEF EXECUTIVE AND COUNCILMEN OF CITY INVOKE AID IN LAW.

SEATTLE, Wash., Aug. 19.—Recall petitions against Mayor George W. Dilling and Councilmen Max Wardall, E. L. Blaine and J. Y. C. Kellogg were filed yesterday with the city comptroller by the Citizens' Recall association, of which Mr. and Mrs. Frank A. Stirton are the leaders.

The petitions will be checked by the comptroller within ten days. If the required number of signatures are found the council will call the election thirty days after the petitions are certified by the comptroller.

The movement for the recall of Mayor Dilling had its inception in the mayor's refusal to discharge Chief Jailer John Corbett, against whom charges of cruelty to prisoners had been made. Corbett was investigated by a grand jury and exonerated.

Mayor Dilling, whose term will expire next spring, was elected last winter at the recall election, in which Mayor Hiram C. Gill was removed from office.

The recall against the three councilmen is based upon their alleged failure to carry on certain campaign pledges regarding street railway legislation. The three councilmen involved took a prominent part in the anti-vice crusade last year

that resulted in the recall of former Mayor Gill and the subsequent indictment and conviction of former Chief of Police Charles W. Wapenston.

## SHERIFF GETS HEAD-DRESS OF INDIAN MIKE

ALTURAS, Aug. 19.—The picturesque headdress of Shoshone Mike, chief of the renegade Indians who massacred four stockmen and several other persons in Northern Nevada last winter and were afterward exterminated in battle with posses of whites, has been received by Sheriff Smith of this county, who was a leader in the battle in which the Indians were killed.

The war plume is of long flaming red cloth with a crown of eagles' feathers and claws. A beautiful, graceful pair of slender ibex horns protrude in odd fashion from the crest. Eagle feathers decorate the long, red streamer, which, when worn, hangs from the crest toward the feet. It is an odd and grotesque souvenir of a memorable event and Sheriff Smith has already been offered \$100 for it, but said that he would not take \$500 for it. It may yet be exhibited at the World's Fair in San Francisco, and may also be seen at the State Fair in Sacramento.

## HAILSTORM DOES DAMAGE.

LETHBRIDGE, Alberta, Canada, Aug. 19.—A hailstorm which traveled through Southern Alberta late yesterday, destroyed probably a million bushels of grain. The worst damage was around Wilson and Sterling, southeast of Lethbridge, where several farms were completely thrashed out.
