Protecting the Miner

Recognizing the necessity of the bureau of mines in protecting the lives of miners, the Goldfield Tribune has the following to say with regard to the call for a conference between officials of the bureau and mine managers:

Only within the past few years has any serious attention been given by mining companies to scientific methods of life saving and life protection in the mines other than the coal mines, where the life of the miner was supposed to be in greater relative jeopardy owing to the presence of inflammable material and explosive or poisonous gases. The work of the comparatively new bureau of mines has been of the greatest benefit in conducting experiments and giving public demonstrations of life saving methods, as well as in agitating for life-saving equipment in mines and extending throughout the country its campaign of education upon this subject.

Following its mine safety demonstration of a year ago, which proved highly successful and of inestimable value to the mining industry, the bureau of mines has announced that it will call a conference of mine managers and others who may be interested, to meet at Pittsburg late this month, when the latest and most efficacious methods of life saving and rescue work, as well as the most approved devices in use in this work, will be exhibited and their application demonstrated for the benefit of the visitors. This work has the active support and co-operation of the American Red Cross society and no more important or effective means of adding to the world's knowledge and ability in the matter of saving and safeguarding human life has ever been undertaken. This will readily be conceded when it is considered that the work of this character is credited with saving some three hundred lives in a single year.
