Legislative Caution

A communication from a well-known banking firm, printed in Wednesday's Commercial, lays great emphasis on a question of vital importance, imbedded in the controversies of the pending canvass, says the New York Commercial. It is the proposition of the slower, more certainly adjusted change which experience has shown, or may show to be called for by the best business interests of the nation, as against any swift and radical departure in destroying the tariff fabric.

The letter in question illustrates the controverted point, by saying that the radical sweep would be as foolish as to attempt to remove a building by use of dynamite rather than to take it down stone by stone. One effects an immediate result in the razing of the building and destroys entirely not only the edifice, but the material from which it was constructed; while the other is the one of reason and conserves the material, while it clears the ground of the debris which encumbered it. It might have been said, that the violent process prevents all current use of the building and vitally affects the business which was transacted in the building.

Such a comparison hits the nail very squarely. The violent alteration, which is the democratic panacea, if carried out in all the details proposed or foreshadowed in the proceedings of the recent session, even if in themselves ideally good, would inevitably disturb very seriously the whole business fabric which had been accommodated to the existing tariff. It would be a year or perhaps two years, before the effects could possibly cease in their dislocating force. Billions of dollars of commerce would feel it like an earthquake. Our democratic friends dispute this, but in that denial they ignore the lesson of all historic experience in trade history.

The tariff policy, on the other hand, of President Taft looks to the beneficence of a reform in tariff excesses, which will not shake business interests, because it follows that more kindly and propitious stages of physical nature itself, whose creative processes in earth changes are gradual in the main, destructively violent only in the exception. The republican policy, which has been best displayed in the Taft expositions and which, indeed, was inspired by that statesman, recognizes, quite as much as does the democratic party, the needs of a final removal of tariff defects, as now demanded by the conditions of both domestic and international trade. But each step must be assured by a thorough investigation of all the facts involved, an inquiry made by a competent body of non-partisan experts with no axes to grind, with no interest, except to get to the foundation of all the facts that environ the essential truth. This substitution of sounder tariff schedules, thoroughly readjusted to conditions as they now stand, would be, with the thorough execution of the Taft ideal of process, continuous and systematic, but by piecemeal, not one whit faster, however, than the best consensus of commercial opinion calls for. There would be no disruption of business affairs, nothing to prevent every line of trade from a happy accommodation of its transactions to the altered requirements.

It is difficult to see how any rational person can fail to approve this process of tariff reform, as long as it rests on the conviction that it will be honestly and capably carried out, rather than the destructive attack of the democratic policy, which would annihilate the old to recreate a better now, should that prove a better condition in the final proof, but at an expense of serious intermediate cost.
