PLATFORM ADOPTED BY REPUBLICANS SHOULD BE READ BY ALL VOTERS

The platform of the republican candidates of Nye county as drafted several weeks ago, should be carefully read by all voters of this county. It contains food for thought, especially that part pledging the legislative candidates to labor for certain measures. For the benefit of those who have not read the platform it is reproduced here in full:

The republican candidates of Nye county assembled in convention, pursuant to the provisions of the primary law, offer no program that is not unworked with performance; makes no promises but what are for the interest of the tax payers and property owners of this county.

The past four years of republican rule in this nation has been such that we again give our hearty endorsement to the platform and candidates presented by the national republican convention. Never has the country been confronted with such problems and situations as have arisen during the last four years, and never have such problems been handled with such skill and courage. President Taft has demonstrated his fitness for the office he now holds, and for which he is a candidate for re-election, and though assailed by agitators and decried by terrorists, the condition of the United States today is a tribute to his performance of every duty demanded.

The state republican platform and candidates likewise receive our unanimous endorsement.

Retrenchment in State Offices


We pledge our legislative candidates to the enactment of a measure reducing the expenses of the state government to conform with the revenues of the state and prevent the further issuance of bonds to meet the deficit in the general fund.

The State Bank Receivership

We pledge our legislative candidates to secure an investigation into the affairs of the long defunct State Bank and Trust company. There are hundreds of people in Nye county who lost their savings in this institution and who are not able to secure a proper report showing the

requests of the bank. Repeated requests have met with silence on the part of the receiver in charge and we pledge our legislative candidates to work for the passage of a resolution through both houses of the legislature, securing the appointment of a committee to conduct a public investigation of the affairs of the bank.

Good Roads

We pledge our county and legislative candidates to adopt every means whereby the roads of this county will be repaired and new thoroughfares constructed. We recognize that good roads mean that hundreds of tourists will pass through our county, and within the next few years thousands of motor driven machines will cross the continent. It is within the power of southern Nevada to provide a feasible route for the travelers, and we pledge all our candidates to secure the enactment of a proper measure that will insure the construction of a

transcontinental route through Nye county.

Primary Election Law

We pledge our legislative candidates to the enactment of sweeping amendments to the present primary law, which in its self is nothing short of farcical. We favor such amendments that will prohibit voters from flocking from one standard to another without a declaration of their political faith. We believe in the sanctity of the ballot and urge that secrecy be continued, but are opposed to the present construction of the primary law that allows fraud being perpetrated.

Free Text Books

We pledge our legislative candidates to labor for the passage of a measure providing for the furnishing of free text books by the state to the pupils attending our public schools.

GOVERNOR ODDIE TO INVESTIGATE THE ELY STRIKE

WILL SPEND SEVERAL DAYS LOOKING INTO CONDITIONS AT COPPER CAMP

Governor T. L. Oddie has gone to Ely where he will conduct an investigation into the conditions governing the recent strike of the miners.

His presence there has been requested owing to the unsettled conditions existing in the big copper camp at the present time. The governor stated that he apprehended no serious trouble, but at the same time believed that it was best that he should personally look over the conditions.

The governor declared that no call had been made for the state police and that there would be any. While in Ely he will confer with both the heads of the strikers and the operators. The governor is of the opinion that the acts of the strikers at Bingham will have more effect on the camp of Ely than any other one thing.

Governor Oddie also stated that the prison board who have the late investigation in hand have made no

decision as yet as the transcript or the evidence has not yet been transcribed.

Regarding the rumors that changes would be made at the prison, the governor stated that the board had taken no action whatever as yet and would not do so until the evidence has been transcribed and meetings held to discuss the affair.
