### ROTARY DRILL BEING WORKED IN RAILROAD VALLEY

SEARCH FOR POTASH DEPOSITS HAS RESULTED IN DISCOVERY OF TRACES

In Railroad valley indications of potash have been found in some of the holes recently put down by the Railroad Valley company with the new rotary drill and the company is diligently prosecuting the work of exploring all the whole low area of the valley in the attempt to locate the deposit of potash salts almost known to exist there. With the new method of drilling much more rapid progress can be made in the prospect work and seven holes have been put down to the depth of from 100 to 250 feet. It is planned to systematically drill a great many holes until the potash is located and as the formations of the valley are studied longer and more is learned of them the belief grows stronger in the minds of the management that the search will be successful in time.

The rotary drill now in use can bring up a core of the solid formations six inches in diameter but the company has ordered another drill that will have a capacity of boring a hole to the depth of 3000 feet and 16 inches in diameter, and of bringing cores to the surface from the depth mentioned. The first work was begun in Railroad valley shortly after the first of this year by means of a churn drill. It was difficult to get a hole through some of the beds of quicksand when using a churn drill as the sand would flow into the casing faster than it could be bailed out. In fact, one streak of quicksand that was struck forced the tools up in the casing so rapidly that the slack of the rope could not be reeled out of the way at the same speed. After investigating the claims of the rotary drill manufacturers it was decided to experiment with the use of one rotary drill and to order a number of others if the first one worked successfully. With the rotary drill the casing is kept down to the bottom of the hole all the time and if quicksand does flow into the cutting tool it can not cause the trouble experienced with the use of the churn drill.

The rotary drills will also be used on the lands embraced in the areas that are to be prepared for development by the company and the holes bored on the lands will be for the

purpose of obtaining water for irrigation from artesian sources. The company has been expecting to have a part of the land ready for cultivation shortly after the first of the coming year and then the actual colonization of the valley will begin and as the plans of the company are developed additional settlers will find homes in the valley which is one of the richest in the state and where the climate is favorable for growing an endless variety of agricultural products.

### NEXT TEACHERS INSTITUTE MAY BE HELD HERE

DETERMINED EFFORT WILL BE MADE TO SECURE NEXT STATE GATHERING

That a determined effort will be made to secure the next teachers' institute for Tonopah is now being planned by B. G. Bleasdale, deputy school superintendent for the fifth district. Bleasdale, in a letter received this morning by Superintendent Yoder of the Tonopah schools, announced that all local teachers who attended the institute at Reno should labor to secure the next meeting for Tonopah. The institute will remain in session from December 16 to 21 and if present plans do not go amiss every one of the 14 local teachers will be in attendance.

Bleasdale stated that the fact of Tonopah's construction of a new \$50,000 school building would prove an inducement to the teachers of the state in visiting this city to view the new structure which will be thoroughly modern. He declared the institute could be secured for Tonopah if the teachers would but labor to that end and to secure the best results he recommended that every Tonopah teacher be in attendance. The trustees of the Tonopah schools will extend an invitation to the Teachers' association to meet in Tonopah two years hence, and as no other city in the state is laboring to secure the institute, it is believed Tonopah will be successful. The institute was held in this city two years ago.
