Tonopah is now harboring two celebrities in the sporting world, the photograph of one which appears above. The celebrities in question are Charlie Perryman and Tonnie Balidar, who recently purchased the Palace bar on upper Main street.

Perryman, who was born in the gold fields of Ballarat, Australia, is a well known figure in the cycling and athletic world, having raced in all of the leading events throughout Australia, and he has to his credit numerous cash handicaps as well as leading road races. In boxing circles Perryman competed in numerous engagements at Victoria, Australia, where he gained an enviable reputation as a master of the gloves.

Some 10 years ago, Perryman, after completing a tour around the world, wound up by covering Australia with a Perryman Diamond bicycle, a wheel of his own manufacture. In 1902 he started in business in South Africa and was so successful that 6000 Perryman bicycles were placed on the South African roads. The famous Diamond road races were also promoted by Perryman.

While proprietor of the Gresham bar and Tramway hotel at Johannesburg many wrestling and boxing bouts were promoted by Perryman. During the sojourn of Yankee Dick Cullen, Bill Smith of Australia and Jack Laylor of England, Perryman officiated as the principal backer of the fighters in their championship bouts. His places of business was the headquarters for the fighters and all articles of agreement were signed in his presence. His hotel was also the headquarters for the great miners' strike in 1907.

Upon leaving Australia to try his fortune in America, Perryman was presented with a handsome illuminated address and gold watch charm by the Johannesburg miners. These presents he still retains.

Perryman built the first patent side dump for the rock, sand, granite and cement in San Francisco and later contracted with the United States army contractors when he hauled rock to the Presidio in San Francisco for the construction of the artillery barracks. He was recently engaged in the saloon business in the bay city, selling his interest in the Panama saloon on Fourth street a month ago.

Tonnie Balidar, Perryman's associate in the Palace bar, is an old time racing cyclist, having competed in many engagements on the continent. He is very popular in Tonopah, having been employed in all of the leading saloons of this camp since his advent here. The many friends of the pair wish them all possible success in their latest venture, and this success is assured by the manner in which the patronage at the new resort has increased during the past week.

Perryman conducted the Senate saloon at Goldfield for several years and during his management the resort was regarded as the most popular bar in the southern city. Both gentlemen are thorough saloon men and understand the art of catering to the public and supplying all demands in a courteous and pleasing manner.

DECLARES WAR ON SLING SHOTS AND AIR GUNS

WEAPONS OF YOUTHS WILL BE CONFISCATED BY CHIEF OF POLICE EVANS

The small boy with the slingshot and the airgun is going to connect with real trouble in Tonopah before long, unless present habits of demolishing windows and aiming at pedestrians are discontinued. Chief of Police Evans announced today that several cases wherein people had been hit by missiles hurled from a slingshot or by shot from an airgun, had been reported to him, and unless the practice was stopped immediately he would confiscate all weapons of this character.

It has been reported that boys have been killing birds in this vicinity. There is a law protecting all birds from death, and a strict enforcement will be made by the chief. Birds are a rarity on the desert and every protection should be afforded them. The wanton killing will be stopped immediately and in the enforcement of the law it is expected that a choice collection of sling shots and air guns will soon be on display at the police office.
