BLUE SKY LAW CONSIDERED IN MANY STATES

NEW YORK WRESTLING WITH BILL THAT HAS MANY OBJECTIONABLE FEATURES.

Few developments in the 1915 crop of legislatures have created the attention and controversy that the country-wide campaign of attempted "blue sky" laws have occasioned. There is now such a bill pending in the New York legislature, which would create a board consisting of the governor, lieutenant governor and others to act as the commission.

Financial America, in its March 28 edition, handles the matter in part as follows: "The question naturally arises will the indorsement or approval of this body to a security flotation involve the state in liability to investors for losses, should the flotation in question prove fictitious or fraudulent. Since we are all human and prone to error, the infallibility of this board should it be created, cannot be taken for granted. What good, then, is its sanction, guarantee or approval to those who follow its decision to their loss? Kansas is now discovering weak spots in its attempt at this sort of regulation, and Indiana, profiting by this experience, is going to appoint a commission to study the question and report to the legislature in 1915. In that time much light should be shed on the practical workings of "blue sky" legislation in general, and if Indiana can wait two years before embarking on a venture of this kind, why should New York act precipitately?

"While fraud and misrepresentation in relation to securities might be checked by the existence of such a board as that contemplated, legitimate investment activities might be affected as well. A stringent public law in relation to corporate offerings, something on the model of the British companies act, should serve the purpose of the reformers who have proposed the measure referred to. A rigid enforcement of that law in England has driven the fraudulent promoter from the investment arena, and as a consequence, investment losses due to glittering prospectuses and alluring get-rich-quick schemes are relatively infinitesimal in Great Britain in comparison with their stupendous total in this country. If Albany were to devote its time to a discussion of the English law afore-mentioned, with a view to adopting the best features of that enactment, it might more profitably serve investors in this state.
