## HAS FAITH IN THE FUTURE OF GOLD BAR MINE

UNIQUE LETTER SENT TO STOCK-HOLDERS BY SECRETARY OF THE COMPANY. Several stockholders of the Bullfrog Gold Bar Consolidated Mines company are in receipt of a unique and expressive communication from the secretary, under date of May 1, and as this communication is one that will go down into the history of the industry on account of its decidedly unusual character, it is here reproduced:

"There are some \$90 record stockholders of Gold Bar. This communication is addressed only to the 200 and over who have failed so far to pay their assessment. 'If your friends were to ask you today: 'What do you think of this Gold Bar reorganization?' you would undoubtedly burst forth and tell him in fitting and proper language just why you have remained out. 'Now, I want to ask you to pretend that I am your friend and to sit down and write me just exactly what you would say to one who asked you the above question. Never mind how firmly your opinions are fixed. It doesn't matter if you have a 'kick' or a 'roast' to give me. Just be a sport and spend a postage stamp and a few moments' time to write me a letter. Don't you feel that you owe at least that much to the money you have tied up in the old stock? Remember, you have the protection of the United States postal authorities. Yours very sincerely, 'E. C. WATSON, Secretary. 'P. S.—You CAN ask questions, too.' It will be recalled by those connected with the mining boom of recent years in Nevada that the Gold Bar, largely a Salt Lake proposi-

tion, was one of the most striking advertisements for the Bullfrog district during the top wave of the boom there. The mine was supposed to be filled with gold ore and the company even installed an expensive mill. Nothing ever came of the proposition except that it dropped out of sight for a time. It is evident that Secretary Watson believes the Gold Bar worthy of attention and that something can be saved out of the wreck of what once was widely thought of as one of the remarkable yellow metal properties of the state of Nevada. If shareholders can bring about improved conditions by the use of a postage stamp, the expense will not add much to their present stock loss. It may be worth trying, anyhow.

## TEXAS SHOWS BIG INCREASE IN AUTOS

That ten thousand automobiles were registered in Texas last year and that the increased use of the automobile in that state is so great as to necessitate new legislation are points submitted in support of a bill about to be presented to the state legislature. The increase in registration over 1911 is 65 per cent, which gives Texas third rank among the states in point of increased registration. West Virginia and Maine leading with 148 per cent and 147 per cent respectively. Automobile accidents increased to such an extent in Dallas that the city council after an investigation passed a new warning signal ordinance as the most effective means of prevention. The ordinance provides for the use of an automobile warning signal "with an abrupt note sufficiently loud to be heard under all conditions of traffic;" and the measure further stipulates that it shall be unlawful to use such signals except when necessary to sound a warning of danger.
