Strictly a Business Bunch

The auto men have come and gone. Their short stay in Tonopah is regretted but that is the fortune of war. They are making an endurance test involving time and speed and there is no disposition to accept courtesies. Most of the riders are in the game from a business standpoint with a sharp eye on the advertising that must ultimately accrue from the feat of crossing the continent in a given time eliminating bursts of speed and constant running. The men with the machines are the same keen eyed groups you see at the races. They are alert to every advantage and are not prone to indulge in any distractions that will take their minds off the goal for which they all are straining. Local animosities and rivalry have been eliminated. From the outset it was accepted as a state affair. The officers of the state automobile association took the hazard of entertaining with the understanding that each community would look after its own interests and the rest of the state would share in the glory of helping the motorists establish a record that would remain as a permanent inducement for future travelers to come the same way.

While it is deplored that Tonopah was not chosen for the banquet it must be accepted with philosophy that the managers of the run could not be governed by any other influence than the question of mileage. The distance has to be negotiated with the proviso that delays should be subtracted from the fixed stops to the end that the finish of the journey would be made on schedule time. The tourists are not addicted to the roystering habit as they are trained athletes with a set task before them and there is little room for any diversion. They are a lot of early birds for they retire with the closing of day are out with the sun next morning. Had they preferred to accept one-half the entertainment offered they would have been surfeited with attention that would necessarily have occupied time to the exclusion of the object lesson which they are demonstrating.

Nevertheless, they have found, notwithstanding reports to the contrary, that the natural roads of southern Nevada are equal to the best made roads of the middle west and this section undoubtedly receive very favorable mention for the guidance of others who will follow in their wake.

The difficulties overcome by the local committee are understood by few and appreciated by less. In the first place the northern route was chosen leaving Tonopah and Goldfield off the map. Then when a change was secured the plan contemplated sending the party by the most direct route to Bishop, California. This would have been via Dry Lake and the Cactus Peak, leaving out Tonopah completely. To modify this schedule involved a great deal of argument and persuasion for which the committee should be thanked. By bringing the tourists to Tonopah the name of this camp will appear in the itinerary of future motorists who will have more time to see and appreciate the importance of this camp.
