CHRISTIAN CHINESE ELIGIBLE TO THE HIGHEST HONORS

(By Associated Press.) PEKING, Dec. 6.—"Members of the Christian community are now free as never before to enter into all forms of activities and to make their influence felt in social life in Peking," says J. S. Burgess, one of the young Princeton men who are conducting one Y. M. C. A. for Chinese and another for the soldiers of the various legation guards in this capital.

As a result of his investigations Mr. Burgess says there are 25,000 rickshaw coolies in Peking, and that many of them not only provide for themselves, but for families of two or three persons on an income of from 10 to 15 coppers, worth less than half the value of the same number of American cents, per day.

SHEEP RAISERS ARE EDUCATING HOUSEWIVES

The men interested in the sheep industry have been making a systematic campaign of late to bring the people to a better understanding of the value of mutton as a food and of the economy in its use when compared with beef and pork.

The sheepraisers have compiled a pamphlet on the subject for general distribution. It is based on government statistics and shows that of 10,000,938 cattle inspected 27,930 carcasses and 49,393 parts were condemned; of 26,916,363 hogs inspected 31,517 carcasses and 870,361 parts were condemned, while of 13,005,502 sheep inspected no carcasses and no parts were condemned.

The same pamphlet maintains that mutton and lamb give the cheapest meats for consumption, not only in price per quantity but in the nourishment and strength given to the human system. While the average of all cuts of beef shows 51.8 per cent of water, 16 per cent of protein, 14.9 per cent of fat and 927 of fuel value in calories, mutton shows 41.3 per cent of water, 12.9 per cent protein, 27.5 per cent of fat and 1403 of fuel values in calories.

The statement is made that "mutton and lamb sell at lower prices than other meats, and you can reduce your meat bill and better your health by always ordering this meat." A quotation is given from James Wilson, secretary of agriculture so many years ago, who says: "I think families of the United States who desire to economize in their meat bill would find marked relief and great satisfaction in the use of mutton. It has been a choice food from time immemorial."

Another is from Swift & Co., the big packers, as follows: "The consumer keeps on demanding the choice cuts of beef when mutton and lamb, fully as nutritious, are being offered at a cheaper price."
