

TONOPAH ROUTE FAVORED BY THE LEADING AUTOISTS. THIS IS THE BEST ALL THE YEAR ROUTE THAT CAN BE DEvised. The automobile club of northern California has come out strongly for the Tonopah transcontinental route to the coast. At a meeting held at the St. Francis hotel the following resolutions were adopted: Whereas, the route of the Lincoln highway in Nevada and California selected by the Lincoln Highway association, is closed to interstate motor car travel over one-half of each year, because of natural climatic conditions on the Sierras; and, Whereas, the Inyo Good Road club of California has made protest against such route because it is so closed to interstate motor car travel, which protest will be presented to said Lincoln Highway association; and, Whereas, said Inyo Good Road club has recommended instead of such route so selected, that "The Exposition Way" now in regular use and open all the year for interstate motor car travel, be adopted as the official route of the Lincoln highway said "Exposition Way" recommended by said club, extending from Ely, Nev., through Tonopah and Goldfield into California at Big Pine, thence through Independence, Manzanar, Lone Pine, Inyo-Kern, Mojave, Tehachapi Pass, Bakersfield, Fresno, Madera, Merced, Modesto and Berkeley to Oakland;

Resolved, By the Automobile Club of Northern California, that it does hereby indorse and approve the action of the Inyo Good Road club in its protest and recommendation to the said Lincoln Highway association. The Modesto chamber of commerce also indorses the action of the Inyo Good Road club on the re-routing of the Lincoln highway through Nevada and California, and pledge hearty moral support.

S. P. CO. TO BUILD TO AVOID SINKS. LINE FROM VALLEJO TO BENICIA WILL GIVE SOLID ROADBED FOR RAILROAD. VALLEJO, Feb. 2.—According to information reaching this city the officials of the Southern Pacific railroad company have about decided to construct the seven-mile link from Vallejo to Benicia this year. From what can be learned the inability of the big transportation company to overcome the troublesome sinks along the main line in the Suisun marsh has been a big factor in the determination to hasten the completion of the link which has been proposed for years. With this stretch of track completed the company would not have to worry over the sinks, as the trains could be routed from Suisun to Benicia by way of Cordelia and Vallejo. At the present time hundreds of men are kept working night and day in the Suisun marsh, and it is only by herculean efforts that the main line is kept in condition for the operation of trains. Much time is lost by the trains, as it is necessary to slow down and practically crawl over the bad spots, which are threatening to sink at any minute. With the completion of the North-ern Electric and the operation of its fast express trains the Southern Pacific will have to be in a position to successfully compete with the electric system, and it cannot do so with tracks suspended on nothing more than air and water. It is understood that Assistant Superintendent Campbell strongly favors the Suisun-Vallejo-Benicia route as the solution of the trouble.

Profit Sharing ON THE COMSTOCK. STURGES COMPANIES ARRANGE TO DIVIDE A PERCENTAGE OF EARNINGS. At the directors' meetings held yesterday afternoon the three Sturges companies of Gold Hill, Yellow Jacket, Crown Point and Belcher passed a resolution that on and after February 1, 1914, and until further orders of each board of directors, each company shall pay to all employees on its payroll, from the general manager down, 1 per cent additional for every \$1000 in excess of \$5000 net return from bullion actually produced from ores extracted from the companies' mines each month. This profit-sharing plan was introduced in coal mining properties controlled by Edward B. Sturges in Pennsylvania some years ago, and it has been to the benefit of employers and employees. For example, when ore extraction from the unwatered lower levels of the Crown Point, Belcher and Yellow Jacket mines is resumed within the next few months, should the monthly net returns from bullion actually produced by any one of these properties be \$15,000 or \$10,000 in excess of \$5000, the employees who receive \$100 per month will each get \$10 additional, and in proportion as to the amount of their wages, or salaries, at the rate of 1 per cent of each \$1000 of profits above the \$5000. The more ore that is taken out and the larger the bullion yield, the greater will be the returns to the employees.—Bulletin.

Family on Ranch FOUND SUFFERING. NEVADA WAY OF DOING THINGS JUST AT THE RIGHT TIME. A rancher arrived in McGill on Monday last and reported that a family residing about ten miles north of Hercules Gap were in distressing circumstances and greatly in need of help. Local officers at McGill reported the matter to Sheriff Crain, who on Tuesday, accompanied by Deputy Constable Alex Baird, loaded an auto with supplies and made a hasty trip to the cabin, where they found Mrs. McMannus and five children, ranging from 18 months to several years of age. The husband and father was at Cherry Creek hustling for work. The family were practically destitute and living in a cabin with a dirt floor. The harder had run very low and the visit of the officers was greatly appreciated by the mother and children. It is probable that the family will be sent to Ely, where they can be better provided for until the husband and father is able to secure work.
