OLD TIME PRINTER EXPLAINS WHY HIS PAPER WAS A FAILURE. The following letter has been received by Editor Fairbanks of the Yerington Times from an old friend of "the stick and rule days, is dated at Albuquerque, N. M. We have thought it worth publishing to show why some good hearts become callous in the newspaper business and others are "scratched" until they bleed to death:

JUDGE ORDERED THREE KILLED IN MEXICALI. ONE AMERICAN ESCAPED: NOW PAPERS FOUND PROVING MEXICAN'S ACT. SAN DIEGO, Feb. 6.—Allegation was made by the authorities of Imperial county that papers were found on Mesa de Salinas, formerly judge of the first instance in Mexicali, Mex., which showed that he had ordered the execution of three American citizens who were shot there January 1 of this year, thus explaining the killing of M. Sanchez and F. Valfet, and the wounding of A. Flores, who was left for dead and crawled across the border, bringing word of the alleged outrage to the American immigration officer on this side of the line.

Dear Old Friend: The last time we met you made me promise to write and tell you something of my past life and how I have lived since those happy days, nearly forty years ago, when you and I worked together at the case on the Cheyenne Sun and the Laraine Boomerang. But particularly you wanted to know how I became such a splendid failure as a newspaper man.

I will tell you some of the experiences that contributed to my journalistic delinquency, hoping you never may know any such yourself, and hoping mine may be a light to warn you off the rocks. First let me tell you, my paper will be a composite picture of the thousand newspapers in the five hundred towns in which I have lived since we were boys together. When I first directed the course of my sheet I steered toward a lofty ideal and placed the honor of the paper above every other consideration, and, sad to say, this seems to have been my first serious mistake. I am convinced that no paper can exist and fulfill a mission unless directed by some political policy, no believing in myself as a statesman inspired I entered the flats—the champion of a great party. And even now, looking back over the vista of years, I am proud—that I lost. For I found (as every honest editor will) that my political gods had feet of clay. I will not detail the experience as it might involve people prominent in the nation's council today, as well as names of some who have gone over the range, and vindictiveness was never a part of my paper. But you know it is not the broken bones—nor hoars for that matter—that prove fatal to a person or a paper. In each instance it is the scratches that kill. So I will recount some of the scratches: One of the most poisonous was the letters that came (I am now ashamed of it) in a feminine hand, slandering and defaming some good woman of the town, and filled with obscenity. These, of course, I refused to print, but noted and commented on them editorially, and very warmly. Now, unreasonable as it may seem, this brought many requests to stop the paper, and not only that, but relinquishing of advertising space.

Salinas and A. M. Pencia, formerly Mexican customs officer at Mexicali, were arrested last week for stealing some papers on the American side of the line. These papers, it is said, proved to be the records of the execution, which had been secured by another Mexican.
