AMERICAN EMIGRATION TO CANADA SHOWED FALLING OFF LAST YEAR

WASHINGTON, D. C., May 7.—The total immigration into Canada in the calendar year 1913 amounted to 412,955, as against 402,654 in 1912. There was a marked decrease in September, October, and November, 1913, which was general from all countries, but was principally noticeable in the case of the United Kingdom and the United States.
