### VALUE OF ADVERTISING.

There are yet unplumbed depths in the human mind and not the least curious is the hypnotic fascination which an overwhelming and spectacular danger has for ordinarily rational beings.

### CANADA'S OIL CRAZE.

It is a time for every man with an itching savings account or otherwise distressful roll to examine, not so much the oil situation, but himself. Conditions at Calgary are likely to be gone over by a hundred market letters and countless stock salesmen; the favorable factors at least are certain of full exploitation. A man's own aptitude for this kind of speculation is, however, a thing of doubt forever. He may win once, but if an outsider, is more apt to lose a thousand times. Not but what huge fortunes are made in oil; few millionaires have come into their heritage so spectacularly as those of Bakersfield and Beaumont. Yet the large majority of the lucky ones were on the ground; many of them were the actual drillers; practically all were willing to take profits here and there in the list without waiting for the topmost dollar of possible quotations. They were in a position to judge the business on its merits, not on the protestations of interested parties.

Mining, particularly for gold and silver, is a trade that requires calmness, judgment, experience, patience, and capital. As the history of American small investors shows, few men possess these attributes in sufficient strength to overcome the risks of the game. Nevertheless, gold mining is a safe business as compared with oil prospecting. The miner can at least see the rock through which he has passed and has some measure of choice as to the direction of each day's work before it is begun. He usually follows a well defined lead of ore whose assays constantly give him some idea as to whether he is approaching or receding from pay ore. If the mining investor instead of gambling blindly, took the necessary pains, he too could ascertain many of the facts whose knowledge are necessary to success.

The oil prospector can have at best only a surface indication to direct his work; a bit of seepage at one point, an upturned strata at another. Once his hole is started he must stick to it and its direction, sometimes without being able to give the slightest guess for thousands of feet as to what his chances may be. The bank of expectations has a thousand "receiving" tellers' wickets, but there is not one sign that says "Paying."

## MOST PROMISING OUTLOOK REPORTED FOR NATIONAL AND BUCKSKIN DISTRICTS

Thomas Defenbaugh, of National, reports conditions at National as very much better.

The National Mines company, the largest operator and producer in the National section, has recently encountered another rich shoot of high-grade in the lowest working and is now producing daily.

The Charleston National Mining company and the National High-grade Leasing company have encountered the National vein at a depth of over 700 feet on the dip of the vein in the White Rock tunnel. They cut the vein after driving 3,160 feet, and they are now raising on the hanging wall for air. They have raised fifty feet and have about 300 feet more to raise to the bottom of the Kennedy-MacDonald incline shaft.

Where they cut the vein it was twenty-six feet in width, with perfect walls, a contact between basalt and andesite. A drift has also been started on the footwall side of the vein and high-grade may be encountered with any round of shots. Altogether their showing is very encouraging and success seems assured. After the raise to the surface is completed, giving them good air and drainage, both leases intend joining in the expense of sinking and will sink 500 feet and probably 1,000 feet below their present lowest level.

The Charleston National Mining company has a four-year lease on the block of ground adjoining the National Mines company on the south, owned by the Charleston Hill Gold Mining company, and the National High-grade Leasing company has a four-year lease on the 600 feet adjoining the Charleston National Mining company to the south, and the vein that has produced the fabulously rich ore of the National Mines company has proven to extend through both leases. J. P. Clough is president of the Charleston National Mining company, C. E. Deardorff, secretary and treasurer, and E. S. Deardorff general manager. In the National High-grade Leasing company A. W. Stowe is the president and general manager, A. L. Brackett vice-pres-

ident, and M. A. Macfarlane is the secretary. George W. Stowe is the superintendent for both companies.

The showing on Buckskin mountain continues to improve. On the Hatch lease, on a block of ground owned by the Buckskin National Mines company, the vein was recently cut in the shaft, showing the same rich quartz, and as soon as timbers can be delivered on the ground sinking will be continued, and every indication is that the Hatch lease will be as rich as the block now being worked by the company on company account. N. P. R. Hatch, of National, is the lucky owner of this lease.

The Buckskin National Mines company has a showing of high-grade and rich milling ore second to none, and is destined to be ranked among the big producing and dividend-paying mine owners of the state. A new high-grade mill has been ordered for this company, and will soon be turning out rich bullion.

The Berry, Staunton-Dunn and other leases on Buckskin National ground are actively at work, but are somewhat delayed until the new road to Buckskin mountain is completed.—Humboldt Star.
