LEACHING PLANT FOR NEVADA DOUGLAS WILL BE OPERATING IN NEXT NINETY DAYS

With the return from the east of A. J. Orem, general superintendent of the Nevada-Douglas Copper Company, comes the official announcement that the leaching plant adaptable to the ores that are of too low grade to be smelted at a profit has been decided upon, material and machinery has been purchased and within 90 days actual treatment will be under way at the property.

On Thursday Mr. Orem returned from a trip of two months through the east, where he made an exhaustive search for acid-proof machinery and material before placing the orders for the leaching plant equipment. He states that actual construction work will be started Tuesday of next week.
