Nevada Republican Platform

At the Republican state convention it was announced that R. A. McKay, who had filed as a Republican candidate for attorney-general, who desired and had attempted to withdraw as a candidate, was granted the privilege of the floor and stated his position and the history of his candidacy and closed by asking the Republican endorsement of Mr. Springmeyer, the Progressive candidate.

Resolved, That the thanks of this convention be tendered Mr. McKay for his courageous and manly action in the premises; that his withdrawal from the list of active Republican candidates be accepted, and that this convention endorse the candidacy of Hon. George Springmeyer for the office of attorney-general and of Hon. Fred J. Trimmer for the office of state printer, and hereby pledge the Republican party to their unqualified support at the polls.

The Republican party, as founded by Lincoln, must endure as the great political party of the nation. Within its mighty membership, dividing at times over issues and again uniting with the differences adjusted by the correcting forces of time and public opinion, is the bond of an enduring union for the common good and welfare of mankind.

The Democratic party came into power two years ago, with the contention that the high cost of living was due to the Republican protective tariff. Its first party measure was the passage of a revenue act, and under the operation of which, after two years, the cost of living has been higher than ever before.
