

## ATLANTA IS NOW A STEADY SHIPPER

INITIAL STOPPING OPERATIONS  
ARE INAUGURATED BY  
MANAGER D'ARCY

The Atlanta is now a regular producer. After making irregular shipments for the last three months, totaling in all 17 carloads, or approximately 800 tons of ore, the property is now sending to the smelters through the Western Ore Purchasing company a carload of ore daily. The initial shipment under the new schedule was made today and General Manager A. I. D'Arcy, to whom is due great credit for the splendid showing the mine is making, is confident that he will be able to send out a car each day, which fact speaks volumes for the physical condition of the property, especially when the difficulties under which operations were conducted until air connection was recently made with the Grizzly Bear mine of the Goldfield Consolidated Mines company is taken into consideration, says the Goldfield Tribune.

From the first of the month until today no shipments were made from the Atlanta. This was due to the fact that during that period Manager D'Arcy gave his attention to improving the railroad facilities for handling the product of the property. Formerly, in loading the railroad cars, it was necessary to draw the ore from the bins at the shaft into mine cars and tram them to the railroad spur a short distance away. During the suspension of shipments the spur was changed and lengthened so that now the railroad cars are loaded directly from the bins, the tramping of the product being eliminated.

## OFFER OLD METAL TO THE GOVERNMENT

GERMANY THANKS THE DONORS  
BUT WILL NOT ACCEPT  
SACRIFICE

BERLIN, May 12.—So great has been the flood of old metals for melting purposes, that the war ministry has had to issue a statement, thanking the donors but declaring the lack of metal is not sufficient to necessitate such sacrifice.

"Of late," says the ministry, "there have been accumulating in the raw materials of war division of the ministry metal objects of all kinds from the household and the factory, even church bells, for the use of the army. It is impossible to thank each sender for his laudable interest, so the war ministry bespeaks in this way its gratitude.

"The army authorities do not wish to take advantage of this movement, because at the present there is no shortage of old metal. Aside from this fact, the less well to do circles of our population would be apt to compete in a spirit of sacrifice in giving to the Fatherland their metal, while in the case of a real shortage, larger supplies and objects, such as roofs, could be used."

## COMPARATIVELY FEW HORSES ARE SHIPPED

BELIEF DEMAND WILL BE EVEN  
GREATER AFTER WAR  
THAN NOW

(By Associated Press.)  
LONDON, May 12.—Cavalry has been so little used in this war and transportation has been so dependent on motor vehicles that it is doubtful whether the demand for American horses is as heavy now as it will be after the war, when the shortage will be felt on the farms of Europe. The United States has shipped less than 100,000 horses to the warring nations since hostilities began. If the number is raised to 240,000, only 1 per cent of the American horse supply has been touched.
