

GOLD MOUNTAIN LEASE AWARDED

Activities are increasing in the Gold Mountain district, six miles south of this city. Yesterday two leases were taken by experienced and successful Round Mountain miners on blocks of ground of the Mammoth group, which is owned by W. S. Taylor and R. B. Govan. They will immediately begin work on their leases and expect to shortly start saving ore, as their ground contains ledges already opened which assay very favorably, free gold being sometimes visible.

Other leases will be let shortly on the mammoth, which property adjoins the Tonopah Divide estate, owned by George Wingfield, H. Cal Brougher, Senator Wils Brougher, Jim Butler and others. The only

work that is being done at present is by two tributaries, Messrs. Grimes & Hanson. There are about 800 feet of workings on the property and many thousands of dollars' worth of ore have been shipped from shallow workings.

The latest shipment sent out by Grimes & Hanson netting them \$64 a ton, even though it included several tons of low grade screenings. The bin is now nearly full and a double carload will be sent out. It is expected that this ore will run \$85 to the ton, although it may be brought down by increasing the tonnage through introducing second grade ore.

From all indications the best ore lies below the present workings and depth will be sought by the tributaries in expectation of opening up one of the big gold producers of southern Nevada.

BORING FOR WATER ON CALIFORNIA LINE

TIDEWATER RAILWAY OFFICIALS DECIDE TO BEGIN DRILLING THIS WEEK

Drilling and experiments to locate underground water channels and resources in the Amargosa desert are to begin this week near Leeland, on the Tonopah and Tidewater railroad. Officials of the road have authorized work of this nature.

At Beatty, in the upper end of the desert, there are many indications of water and an appreciable flow sings under the desert sands. At the other end of the desert are similar indications. The location of the connecting underground channel

is the goal. Should the experiments prove successful, the desert would probably become well settled, as the climate is mild and invigorating. A well known Los Angeles firm has been awarded the contract, and the machinery, drills and casings are now at the spot where the first work is to begin.

GOOD TUNGSTEN SHOWING

Tom McManus came in Saturday from his tungsten property, which is located twelve miles northwest from Siebert's camp. He brought in some splendid specimens of huebnerite and cheselite, which assay up to 60 per cent. At one place Mr. McManus has opened up his ore shoot from a width of fifteen feet.
