

APPEAL SENT FORTH TO WOMEN OF NEVADA

HELP IS ASKED TO ROLL UP WOMEN'S VOTE OF PROTEST AGAINST OPPONENTS

From the state headquarters of the Woman's party there is being issued to all the registered women of Nevada an appeal just received from Alice Paul, chairman of the Congressional Union, an organization of thousands of eastern women.

This appeal asks western women to vote against President Wilson and the Democratic candidates for congress and thus stand by the unfranchised women of the east who during the last four years have been vainly pleading with the president and his party to pass the national suffrage amendment through congress.

Miss Paul, who has led the fight in Washington, declares that the Democrats have blocked the women's "way to freedom" and begs women voters not to use their votes to return this party to power for four years more of opposition to the political recognition of women.

The appeal says: We, unfranchised women in 36 states, appeal to you, women voters of the west, to help us in our struggle for political liberty.

Together we believe in a free womanhood. But here in the east we are powerless to alter governments not responsible to us.

The strength of party organizations in the thickly populated eastern states, the throngs of foreign born citizens, unfamiliar with our tongue, the liberality of our state constitutions, in many cases impossible to amend, close to us the door of enfranchisement by work in our own states.

We turn to congress; and there our greatest strength and best ally is the vote of four million women enfranchised in the west.

But this strength, to help women, must be used for them at the polls.

Politicians of all parties want votes—your votes. We are asking you to make it clear to them that no party will get the support of women which has denied justice to women.

For four years we have entreated President Wilson and the Democratic party to favor the federal amendment enfranchising women and permit it to go through congress so that the states might act upon it. He has refused, and his party has blocked its passage.

TUNGSTEN DEAL MADE BY TONOPAH PEOPLE

OTHER PROPERTIES AT MCKAY CITY MAY CHANGE HANDS IN NEAR FUTURE

Papers in the deal on the McKay tungsten property at Garnet, east of Mina 18 miles, were signed up today and the Atkins-Kroll company takes over the vast holdings on a bond calling for \$25,000. Several weeks ago Sol M. Summerfield and Paul Kienopple took an option on the property, and they in turn have sold to the Atkins-Kroll company, which is now in possession. That company has not yet given out its intention further than that operations are to begin at once, but it is very probable that the ore will be treated in its mill at Sodaville or a mill will be built on the ground, as there is plenty of water on the holdings, says the Western Nevada Miner.

The property is in the Pilot mountains and consist of a group of 27 claims tied in a compact body and owned by Jim McKay, Nick Ableman, J. Jordan, H. M. Clifford, John Manion, George W. Quigley, George W. Clark, H. B. Peterson, Jack Shepard and John Cornbelk. The camp was an early day location made by Judge Averill, Bob Stewart and H. C. Cutting, who were prospecting for silver without any thought or knowledge of the latter day metal which now commands such a high price. The original name was Stewart's Cabin and the district was christened the Shoshone Mining district.

The tungsten occurs in scheelite in a garnet formation in ten parallel ledges, some of which are 50 feet in width. Samples from these ledges run between 1 and 20 per cent, and a fair average is regarded as close

to three per cent, which would make the deposit one of rare value. The ledge also carries gold and silver, but the tungsten is a beautiful concentrating ore that runs on the plates as easily as gold. This has been demonstrated by panning where the values peel right off, "like taking clothes off the bed," as one locator said.

There are several incline shafts on the group, but the main workings have been opened up through a shaft sunk on Gun Metal claim No. 3 on that part of the property known as the McKay-Ableman group. This shaft is down quite a depth. Three springs on the property have a capacity sufficient to run a concentrator of 100 tons capacity. Samples taken across eight feet of ore gave in one instance 6.80 per cent of tungsten acid. By those who are competent to judge, the property is said to be the biggest deposit of tungsten ore in the United States, if not in the world. Actively operated by the Atkins-Kroll company, it will make Mineral county the center of the tungsten business in the United States.

The foregoing article was shown to local owners of properties at McKay City before it was republished. They state that it is correct with the exception that only four claims and a fraction have been actually transferred. There are still many claims under consideration, not only by the Atkins-Kroll people, but by other prospective purchasers.

JURY TO TRY WILSON

After a new venire of jurors had been drawn, Judge Stoddard at Reno has succeeded in obtaining a jury to try Fred Wilson, charged with the murder of a Japanese restaurant keeper three years ago, and the trial is proceeding. Previous attempts to secure a jury from the old venire failed, the jurors being disqualified for various reasons. Some stated they were opposed to capital punishment and others expressed prejudice against Japanese.
