

# IRON CROWN HAS GOOD SHOWING OPERATOR MINE READY TO SINK

One of the important discoveries in the divide district was made recently on the Iron Crown Divide which struck up at the depth of ten feet in the shaft; a nice looking ledge that has been uncovered on the footwall, showing a width of 12 feet, assays very good values in gold and silver with a showing of \$42.80 per ton of the entire face. The find was not a surprise to the management as the officers have always anticipated the proximity of the goldsmith divide vein would bring good results in the Iron Crown.

Under the management of Thomas J. Lynch, the Operator Mine is getting down to brass tacks through completion of its surface equipment which includes a five drill compressor, 27 horse power hoist, transformer house, blacksmith shop and foreman's residence. The latter was brought over from Goldfield by the Aubrey outfit and planted close to the headframe. The engine house is a model of convenience and comfort and will be lined with sheathing for the winter season. The several houses will be heated by fuel oil stoves. The Operator has four full parallel claims near the Tugery and therefore in the heart of the district. The shaft has been sunk by hand to a depth of 50 feet and after the power is applied double shift will hurry the sinking.
