

# GOVERNORS ATTEND SALT LAKE MEETING

(By Associated Press)

SALT LAKE CITY, Aug. 19.—Problems affecting state governments were to be thoroughly threshed out today at the opening business session of the annual governors' conference which convened here last night. Chief executives from all western states and many eastern and middlewestern commonwealths were in attendance.

Questions to be discussed at today's session included the state budget system, and the growth and consolidation of administrative boards of the different states. Entertainment features included bathing and dancing at the Saltair bathing resort on Great Salt Lake and an informal dinner tendered by Governor Simon Hamblen of Utah. More than twenty state executives were in attendance at the opening of the conference last night, at which addresses of welcome and response were made, followed by an informal public reception. The business meetings are being held in the assembly room of the House of Representatives at the state capital.

Governors present today included those from Arizona, Colorado, Connecticut, Delaware, Idaho, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Maryland, Minnesota, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New Mexico, North Carolina, North Dakota, Oregon, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Washington, West Virginia and Wyoming.

Wednesday the governors will take up under the war problems and "resumption of remedial legislation enacted by legislatures in 1919" under which question will come education, labor and agriculture. The principal problem to be discussed Thursday will be expansion of the national guard system as a basis for national defense. Entertainment features each day include a visit to the famous copper mines at Bingham, about 45 miles southwest of this city, and a trip to Dohen and Weber canyons. The gov-

ernors will leave Thursday evening, August 21, for a three-day tour of Yellowstone park, returning to Salt Lake Monday morning, from here to return to their homes or to the Pacific coast on pleasure trips.

While their early object was mining tungsten, their discovery of silver with lead and copper so outshaded the tungsten prospects, that it turned the property into a silver mine. In silver the ore runs from 20 to 3000 ounces while the general ore will run better than \$100 in silver and copper. It is entirely tunnel work and over 600 feet back can be had with all work done directly on the ledge, the apex shows 25 in silver.



The outcome of this decision was the organization of the Mina Commercial Club, whose membership at this time includes practically all of the business men and mining men of Mineral county.

A few days later the Bureau of Mines, consisting of mine operators only, came into being, as an adjunct of the Commercial Club.

The officers of the Commercial Club are: President, R. R. Gamble; vice-president, B. F. Baker; secretary and treasurer, C. C. Mathews. The officers of the Bureau of Mines are: Chairman, P. A. Simon, treasurer, B. W. Zachau; secretary, J. E. Greenan.

The purpose of the Bureau of Mines is to use all proper means to aid and encourage every legitimate mining proposition, to stimulate prospecting, and more than all else, to discourage the promiscuous floating of wildcat mining companies, which have in certain districts, done so much to disgust the investing public.

## MORE CHURCHES FOR NEVADANS

Extensive plans for development of the Episcopal church in Nevada are revealed in the survey of the church's needs recently sent to the New York headquarters of the Nation-Wide Campaign by Bishop George C. Huntington of Reno. It is planned to construct a chapel at the Reno State University, where 10 per cent of the students are either Episcopal communicants or Episcopal by affiliation. At Sparks a rectory is to be built which will be in charge of Major Henry R. Sanborn after he has been

ordained. Major Sanborn is well known for his church work up and down the coast for returning soldiers.


A mission house and common room is planned at the Indian reservation at Hoopa. It is planned to build an Episcopal church and provide a minister at Lovelock. Another church is projected at Good Springs, and at Caliente it is planned to purchase the present Mormon church and make it an Episcopal church.

Bishop Huntington also plans to take down in sections the present church structure at Goldconda, and re-erect it at Midas, transporting it sixty miles by motor truck. It is also planned to build a church at McGill. The development in Nevada is in line with the proposed church development throughout the nation, as a result of the nationwide campaign.
