SPARKS SHOPS NOT TO CLOSE

Persistent rumors that the Sparks shopmen and roadmen have taken a strike vote in sympathy with the Los Angeles strikers were pronounced false by both union and railroad officials at Sparks. It had been reported on the streets of Reno that placards had been posted in the Sparks shops, says the Gazette, announcing that the men are to go out, but Sparks men denied that any action whatever had been taken.

The Sparks unions are very conservative on the strike question and say that unless ballots come from national headquarters of the labor federations that nothing will be done. Railroad officials report that traffic is being maintained without impairment on the northern route of the Southern Pacific and that the only effect the strike in Los Angeles has been to increase traffic over the northern route by routing goods over it that would formerly have gone the southern way.

An embargo upon shipments to Los Angeles has been ordered by the railroad officials and passengers advised not to attempt to get to points farther south than San Luis Obispo.
