Her death was hastened, her intimates say, by worry over her domestic trouble and her fight to retain custody of her three children. At the time of her death her parents and Dr. Adelaide L. Ohear were at her bedside. The funeral services will be tomorrow afternoon at 1:30 at the Jewel City undertaking parlors at Glendale. Following the recent suits and while Mrs. Mahana lay at the point of death at her father's home, her attorneys stated that in the case of Mrs. Mahana's death the three children would be placed in the custody of her parents, according to a request made by her in her will.
