

PRIMARIES ON MARCH 27

Primary plans for the republican primaries and convention for nominating delegates to the national convention at Chicago were adopted by the executive committee of the state central committee held Saturday night delegates from each county to the state convention were appointed by the executive committee. There will be 111 delegates apportioned as follows:

Clark, five; Churchill, seven; Douglas, three; Elko, four; Esmeralda, four; Humboldt, two; Lincoln, two; Lyon, seven; Mineral, three; Nye, eight; Ormside, five; Pershing, three; Storey, three; Washoe, thirty-three; White Pine, eight.

The apportionment was made on a basis of one for every 100 votes, or fraction over thirty cast for the republican candidate for representative in congress last year.

The executive committee issued the formal call for the primary election, which is to be held on March 27 in each county, and for the delegates to the national convention, the state convention to be held at Reno on April 24.

The committee decided to make no provision whereby an expression of opinion for president may be recorded at the primary election.

IMPORANT NOTICE
To Secretaries of Corporations Doing Business in Nevada But Incorporated in Other States
NOT TOO LATE TO SAVE \$100 PER MONTH

SECTION 1.—All foreign corporations doing business in the State of Nevada shall, not later than the month of March in each year, beginning in the year 1914, publish a statement of their last year's business in some newspaper published in the State of Nevada.

SECTION 2.—The secretary of the company publishing the statement shall file a copy with the assessor of each county of the State of Nevada, in which said company is doing business.

SECTION 3.—Any district attorney in the state is competent to sue to recover the penalty, or the attorney general. The first county suing through its district attorney shall secure the penalty, and if no suit is brought for the penalty by any district attorney the State shall have the right to recover through its attorney general.
