HISTORIC STEAMER GOES TO PIECES. SANTA BARBARA, April 14.—Word was received here recently that the historic old steamer Breakwater broke to pieces off the coast of Mexico, about fifty miles north of Puerto. While the crew was making a landing the third officer was drowned, but Captain Wayland and the rest of the crew were reported safe.

PRECIOUS METALS FOUND IN SHALE. According to a dispatch under a Denver date, chemists of that city who have been conducting extensive experiments with oil shale have just made the important discovery that gold and platinum exist in considerable quantities in the oil bearing shales of Colorado, Wyoming, Utah and Nevada.

AMEND PLACER LAW OF YUKON. Correspondence Associated Press) DAWSON, April 14.—Amendment of the Dominion placer mining laws for Yukon Territory, to permit extensive prospecting of low grade placer creeks and valleys, for the purpose of inducing dredging companies to extend their operations, will be asked of the Dominion government by the Yukon Development League, it was decided recently.

MUST GET RID OF M'KINNON. Is the presence of Hector McKinnon in Mina a violation of his parole? The question gave state officers and officers of Mineral county considerable concern yesterday, and telephone wires were kept busy in an effort to arrive at a clear understanding of the situation.

OIL SHALE ON A SMALL SCALE. Major Henry G. Catlin, who arrived in Eureka last Wednesday from his home in New York, said that the past winter had been one of the worst seasons ever known in the east, says the Eureka Sentinel. Major Catlin is a brother of Robert M. Catlin, who owns the oil shale plants at Elko, and in commenting upon the success of the latter the major said: "My brother's venture is an experiment. He is trying various machinery and testing different methods of treating the shale. The great problem in the extracting of oil from shale in this country is one of quantity. So far success has only been attained by using less than one-ton capacity retorts for heating the shale. This is necessary because shale is a poor conductor of heat, and large quantities cannot be treated in a single retort. Oil can be extracted from shale in profitable quantities in this country only when a process is perfected whereby the shale can be fed into the retorts in vast amounts and the oil drawn out. Ordinarily shale-oil cannot compete with natural oil on the market, because of the expense of production.

SEMENOFF SAFE WITH CHINESE

Correspondence Associated Press) PEKIN, March 21.—The Russian Bolsheviks have demanded that the Chinese surrender to them the person of General Semenov, who succeeded Admiral Kolchak as head of the All-Russia government. The Chinese government has refused to accede to the demand, but has notified the military governors of Manchuria, where Semenov took refuge after leaving Siberia, that he must either desert or leave Chinese territory. The governors were directed to keep a close watch of the former Cossack commander while he remains in Manchuria.

ELY MAN HONORED BY FEDERAL APPOINTMENT

Anthony Jurich, one of the best known attorneys of the state, was notified by wire on Tuesday last of his appointment to the important position of special assistant to United States Attorney General Palmer and will leave in a few days for Washington to personally investigate the duties which will be required of him under the appointment. Mr. Jurich has not yet decided to accept the appointment as it would necessitate the giving up of his lucrative practice here, and also his leadership of the progressive element of the democratic party.

Mr. Jurich's many friends in the district will be pleased to learn that even should he accept the appointment he does not contemplate giving up his residence here, where he has resided for fifteen years. Naturally he is pleased with the honor which is conferred upon him by the appointment to such a responsible position. Hence the probabilities are that he will be absent from Ely until the passing out of the present administration.—Ely Record
