HONOLULU, T. H., Aug. 2.—Chaulmoogra oil, which scientists of the University of Hawaii believe can arrest, if not completely cure leprosy, will be produced on a large scale in Hawaii under arrangements being made by the territorial board of agriculture and forestry.  
Professor Joseph F. Rock, botanist with the United States department of agriculture, who is en route to Burma and India to obtain seeds of the chaulmoogra tree, has been commissioned to bring back a consignment of the seeds to Hawaii for propagation purposes.  
Thirty patients recently were liberated as cured from the Kalaik leper station here after having received the treatment prescribed by Dr. A. L. Dean of the University of Hawaii, who perfected the system of refining chaulmoogra oil.
