HONOLULU TO HAVE GARRISON

(By Associated Press) HONOLULU, T. H., Dec. 18.—The island of Oahu, all of which is included in the city and county of Honolulu, will have a garrison of 15,000 men, exclusive of quarter-master corps, transport corps, headquarters detachment and medical corps according to recent war department advices received by the Hawaiian department. The total of all ranks, it is estimated, will be in excess of 20,000 men.

The United States force on Oahu will be composed as follows: Five regiments of infantry, with a total strength of 321 officers and 8338 men, one division of field artillery, with 111 officers and 2116 men, and one 155-mm howitzer regiment with 51 officers and 1064 men.

Coast artillery, 119 officers and 3229 men; one regiment of cavalry with 44 officers and 974 men, heavy-transport service, including one group for headquarters, two observation squadrons, photographic section, one air park, totaling 72 officers and 491 men; lighter-than-air service, including one headquarters group, two balloon companies, totaling 13 officers and 218 men; one regiment engineers at peace strength with 26 officers and 719 men; signal corps of 10 officers and 205 men.

MAY ERECT STADIUM TO COST FORTUNE

(By Associated Press) LOS ANGELES, Cal., Dec. 18.—The University of Southern California is the latest California university to announce that plans are being made for construction of an athletic stadium for intercollegiate games.

The proposed U. S. C. stadium will cost more than \$100,000 and will replace Bovard field, where all the games and track meets are held at present.
