**CHAMPION RIDER RECOVERS SIGHT**

SAN JOSE, Cal., Jan. 28.—Otto Ziegler, San Jose, who in the late nineties held several bicycle speed records and later won the title of world champion rider, is slowly recovering his sight after spending nine years in darkness at a state school for the blind in Oakland, California.

A 1914 Zeppelin suffered while racing in Seattle, Washington, led to his blindness. About one year ago he began to see light, and now his doctor says he will regain his lost sight within a year.

Ziegler has never seen an airplane or a modern automobile. "I've heard the airplanes overhead and have often tried to imagine what they are like," he said recently. Discussing automobiles, he said the ones he remembers were the rough riding models of 1910 with backs protruding high above the body lines. "I can tell the big improvements of their riding qualities and the fact that they do not make so much noise," he asserted.

When Ziegler comes back to San Jose after recovering his sight, he will be reminded of a reception he received years ago when he came home from Denver after breaking several world records. It is said that one of the largest crowds ever assembled in San Jose up to that time was at the railroad station to meet him for bicycle racing was a relic of a carriage which was used just prior to the party President Taft held about the city.
