

**LOW-NECKED GOWNS MEAN HIGH INSURANCE**

(By Associated Press)  
 GENEVA, March 29.—Swiss women who wear short skirts and low-necked gowns will have to pay higher rates of life insurance than those who do not. The Swiss insurance companies have announced that fixing the premiums on policies of women's lives they will take into consideration the women's wearing apparel. The shorter the skirt or lower the décolleté, the higher the insurance rate will be.

The Swiss companies justify this action on the ground of a great increase of illness and disease among their women clients which they claim is due to the wearing of short skirts and low-necked dresses.

**TO GET SOCKEYE SALMON BACK**

 OLYMPIA, Wash., March 29.—Efforts to induce sockeye salmon to come back to Puget Sound again in large numbers are to be made by the Washington state department of fisheries. For years the sockeye formed a big part of the annual catch of Washington fishermen but since 1915 the runs have been very small.

Every four years the sockeye run in large numbers. In 1915 a record run was reported, but in that year many of the fish were prevented by landslides in Hell Gate canyon from reaching their natural spawning grounds in the Fraser river of British Columbia. The slides, it was said, were caused by construction work on a Canadian railroad. Since 1915 the runs have been disappointing.

Plans are now being made to establish on the Fraser river hatcheries operated jointly by the state of Washington and the government of British Columbia. If British Columbia does not care to help in the move, it is promised to develop sockeye hatcheries along the northern Washington coast and endeavor to build up a sockeye run in Washington waters exclusively. The state legislature has set aside \$100,000 for the work.

Years ago the run of the Columbia river salmon was developed through co-operation of Washington and Oregon, and experts are certain the sockeye can be restored.

Another plan of the department to aid fishermen is to hatch eggs of the Alaska red salmon in the state as a means of providing ample catches for fishermen in the so-called "lean" years when the fish do not run.

**HENS CAN'T FAKE WITH TRAP NESTS**

 WASHINGTON, D. C., March 29.—The hen that did the cackling may not have laid the egg, government farm experts assert. They advise farmers to use trap nests in order to pin the cackler down to facts in the way of eggs.

By holding a hen on the nest until released, the announcement said, it was possible to keep tab on the good layers, regardless of the fuss raised by some hens on false pretenses.

**ERECT PYRAMIDS WHERE GERMANS WERE STOPPED**

 PARIS, March 27.—To mark the line where the German advance in the spring of 1918 was stopped it is proposed to erect pyramids along the entire front bearing the inscription: "Here was arrested the rush of the barbarians."

The number of pyramids and the places where they are to be erected will shortly be determined by Marshal Petain.

The highway, it is predicted, will be one of the most beautiful river and redwood forest drives in northern California.
