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HIGH SCHOOL DRONES

William Dean Lewis, deputy state superintendent of schools of Pennsylvania, speaking in Philadelphia the other day, said that "killing time in high schools is murder in the first degree" for which pupils should be sentenced to "seek other fields." Educators are becoming more and more concerned over the inefficiency that is manifested by pupils in the higher grades of the public schools. Many graduates of high schools, although able to pass the tests necessary to obtain diplomas, are unfitted for engaging in any practical work of life.

One of the chief assets of a high school education is instruction in methods of thought, the acquisition of the ability to make use of the knowledge that has been obtained in the textbooks. When Mr. Lewis refers to killing time in the schools as being "murder in the first degree" he has in mind the death of the things that should be acquired during one of the most valuable periods in the life of the young man or young woman, the period when the foundation for future usefulness should be laid deep and broad, through the training of the mental powers along practical lines.

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
