TONOPAH M. CO. EARNINGS ARE QUITE HEAVY

Increased Tonnage Marks Progress of Development at This Big Producer.

SHOWING STEADILY IMPROVES

Desert Mill is Furnished Ample Material to Keep Machinery in Steady Operation.

Increased tonnage of ore is marking development progress at the properties of the Tonopah Mining company. During the week ending Monday, February 13, the underground work consisted of 326 feet, distributed at the three shafts as follows: Silver Top, 114 feet; Mizpah, 184 feet; Sand Grass shaft, 28 feet. The ore tonnage for the week amounted to 1500 tons, extraction resulting as follows: Silver Top, 350 tons; Mizpah, 700 tons; Sand Grass, 450 tons.

HEAVY OUTPUT IS MAINTAINED FROM BELMONT

Operations Are Going Forward On Six Different Levels of This Great Producer.

PRODUCTION IS AUGMENTED

Coming Summer Promises to Witness This Property Increase Bullion Output.

The physical condition of the three properties is reported as being splendid, off stope 1180, Rescue vein, 2 feet low grade ore. West drift, 11908, off south crosscut 1150, 11908 vein, prospecting fault. North crosscut 1199, off southwest crosscut 1145, prospecting in Mizpah trachyte.

The Tonopah Belmont Development company continues to set a fast pace from a production and development standpoint and the usual tonnage of ore is being maintained at this famous producer. Development is going forward on the 800, 900, 1000, 1100, 1200 and 1300 levels, and splendid ore showings are in evidence throughout the many workings.

With the weather clearing there should be a substantial increase in tonnage consigned to the big Belmont milling plant from outside districts where a number of properties have been developed to the shipping stage during the past winter, although it has been impossible to transport the ore to the reduction plants by reason of poor condition of the roads.

Development for the week ending Friday, March 17, for the preceding seven days, was as follows:

"800 level—Raise 65, off north crosscut 800, prospecting for North vein. Raise 66, off northeast crosscut 830, holed to stope 8043, its objective. Raise 67, off stope 855, holed to north crosscut 707, its objective. Raise 68, off west crosscut 8052, cut Mizpah vein and holed to stope 845.

"900 level—Northeast crosscut 9092, off north crosscut 9085, mining purposes. Intermediate northwest crosscut, off stope 9052, prospecting for faulted segment of South vein. Raise 98, off east drift 9053, cut Favorite vein, 3 feet of good milling ore. Raise 97, off north crosscut 9044, prospecting hanging-wall of North vein. Raise 99, off east drift 9053, prospecting hanging-wall of North vein.

"1000 level—West drift 10040, off northeast crosscut 10039, South vein, 3 feet low grade ore. North crosscut, 10077, off east drift 10005, prospecting hanging-wall of Rescue vein. Intermediate east drift, off raise 118 Mizpah fault (A) vein, 2 feet milling ore.

"1100 level—Intermediate east

Raise 4062 satisfactory progress was made on one foot of low grade quartz in the footwall of Mizpah vein. Raise 569 intermediate, has holed into Mizpah vein. Raise 587 has holed into stope 567 and will be used for removal of ore. Raise 585, short distance was made on ore in the footwall of the Mizpah vein. Crosscut 590, N. P., usual progress, with no change to report. Crosscut 632, was continued in low grade quartz. Development, 184 feet; tonnage, 700.

Sand Grass
"Crosscut 1109 has been started for prospecting purposes. Development, 28 feet; tonnage, 450.

IMPORTANT NOTICE
To Secretaries of Corporations Doing Business in Nevada But Incorporated in Other States
OUR CHARGE \$9.00

SECTION 1.—All foreign corporations doing business in the State of Nevada shall, not later than the month of March in each year, beginning in the year 1914, publish a statement of their last year's business in some newspaper published in the State of Nevada. If published in a daily newspaper, such statement shall be published for a period of one week, or if published in a semi-weekly or tri-weekly newspaper, for a period of two weeks; or if published in a weekly newspaper for a period of four weeks.

SECTION 2.—The secretary of the company publishing the statement shall file a copy with the assessor of each county of the State of Nevada, in which said company is doing business.

SECTION 4.—Any district attorney in the state is competent to sue to recover the penalty, or the attorney general. The first county suing through its district attorney shall secure the penalty, and if no suit is brought for the penalty by any district the State shall have the right to recover through its attorney-general.

The TONOPAH DAILY BONANZA will make publication required by law, which includes the filing of a sworn affidavit of publication with the assessor of each of the counties of the State, within which the company is doing business; an affidavit of publication will also be furnished secretaries.
