

GREAT BELMONT IS OPERATING WITH RESULTS

Bullion Output for Month Was Up to Previous High Standard

REAL DEVELOPMENT STARTS

New Territory to Southwest of Present Workings Will Be Thoroughly Explored

Tonopah Belmont produced during the month of September a total of \$187,300 from its milling operations. The first shipment of bullion, which covered the first fifteen days of the month, totaled \$94,300, while the second shipment that was made this week was worth \$93,000. The mill is not operating to capacity by any means, but increased shipments are being received from outside and adjoining properties which promise to increase the bullion output gradually from time to time.

Development is being prosecuted on eight different levels. One of the most important pieces of work that has been undertaken in a long time is now in order on the 1500 level, where a crosscut is being driven southwest to prospect a territory believed to contain great riches, and the outcome of this development will be watched with interest by all having the best interest of Tonopah at heart.

Official report of development for the nine-day period ending Sept. 30 is as follows:

700 level—A northeast crosscut has been started off of north crosscut 701 for the purpose of prospecting a block of trachyte in the hanging wall of the Stone Cabin fault.

800 level—Intermediate east drift off of raise 850 has been discontinued. Intermediate south crosscut off of raise 850 has been temporarily discontinued. The intermediate south west crosscut off of stope 8043 has connected with raise 85, and a drift has been started on a streak of quartz cut in making the connection. Raise 69 has been discontinued.

900 level—West drift 9035 is being advanced on a foot of quartz. Intermediate east drift and intermediate west drift off of the south crosscut, off of stope 910, have been discontinued.

1000 level—Southeast crosscut 10025 is being driven to prospect for the 1000 vein on this level. East drift 10086 has been started on a streak of quartz picked up in north crosscut 1055.

1100 level—Intermediate southwest crosscut off of stope 80 has been stopped and a raise will be started. Raise 135 has connected with the 1000 level. Raise 136 has connected with the intermediate above and has been stopped.

1200 level—Intermediate northeast crosscut, off of the south crosscut, off

of east stope 7, is prospecting trachyte in the footwall of the Belmont vein.

1300 level—Raise 42 has holed to the 1200 level and stoping is in progress on the footwall branch of the Belmont vein.

1500 level—Southwest crosscut is being driven to prospect the southwest section of the property.
